<p><b>CAMH - Buprenorphine-Naloxone Treatment for Opioid Use Disorder</b></p> <p><b>Description</b></p> <p>This course aims to present a framework for providing maintenance treatment for opioid use disorder with buprenorphine/naloxone, including its use in a primary care setting. The course walks the learner through the key elements of selecting, preparing, initiating and maintaining a patient with opioid use disorder on buprenorphine/naloxone treatment. A blend of narrative text, video role-plays, short answer and multiple choice questions frame the course.
